## Take it over, council urged

**TOLMERS** Village Association, a community organisation defending a 12-acre neighbourhood in Camden, London, against rampant property speculation, is launching a new campaign.

Co-ordinator Nick Wates said yesterday that a delegation is seeing the council next Monday to demand that it compulsorily purchase five acres of land and property now owned by Mr. Joe Levy's outfit, Stock Conversion.

Of the 67 houses owned by Levys, 14 are completely empty, or occupied by squatters, and 31 are partially empty. More than 240 habitable rooms are

empty, representing 39 per cent of the area's housing stock, claims a report by the association.

The association will also be seeking guarantees from the council that no existing residences and businesses will be displaced against their will, and that all tenants who want to move will be rehoused, when all the property comes into council ownership.

According to the association Levys has been neglecting properties. "This is to hasten the day day when the area will have to be completely demolished and redeveloped," Mr. Wates alleged.

"Once this situation is reached, Levy hopes he will be able to force through his original deal in which he hoped to make £20 million with office and commercial development," he added.
