Tolmers — a new meeting

A SPECIAL meeting of Camden Council's Community Planning Committee is to be held on September 4 to discuss the Tolmers Square development.

The council has asked for counsel's opinion on the legal implications of the choice between the two developers interested in the scheme, Mr Joe Levy's Stock Conversion and Investment Trust, and Mr Christopher Booker and Mr Bennie Gray's Claudius Properties.

The Claudius offer would channel the commercial profits back to the community and give Camden a better financial prospect, but Stock Conversion already owns half the site and would have to be bought out by compulsory purchase if its scheme were rejected.
