TOLMERS Square yesterday, where Britain's longest and most celebrated squat is due to end peacefully sometime this week.

Only a handful of people remain in the 120-year-old derelict houses in the crumbling square, near Euston Station in London. Little resistance is expected when the sheriff comes to evict them. At times up to 200 squatters have lived there since the occupation began six years ago. Camden Council plans homes and offices in the square.
